

**Art:**

- Color berry picking pictures provided.
- Draw original pictures.
- Create designs with berry leaves.
- Make games with berry leaves.

**Writing Activities:**

- Keep notes and/or journals about berry picking trips.
- Write an original berry-picking story.
- Compose a poem about picking berries.
- Design and make a book for berry identification.
- Prepare a recipe book.

**Reading Activities:**

- Research berry information in reference books.
- Read stories and poems about berries.

**Community Guests:**

- Invite elders to the school who have a knowledge of local berries and places to pick them.

**Science:**

- Locate and identify berries and plants (including poisonous ones).
- Learn of the antioxidant properties and nutritional values of local berries.

**Mathematics:**

- Cook traditional recipes while developing concepts of ratios and proportions, and practicing measurement and conversions.

**Health and PE:**

- Go on field trips to pick berries.
- Find out the medicinal value of certain berries.

**Social Sciences:**

- Learn local cultural and traditional history and the values of berries and berry picking.
- Map the local area to show where berries grow.

**Arts Activities:**

- Student will sketch and paint trees in their natural habitat.
  - Students will use tree leaves, bark, roots, etc. for various art projects. Students will make items with tree products – boxes, baskets, etc.

**Community Service Activities:**

- Host an Open House for the Community to learn about berries.
- Prepare booklets and videos for the Community.

**Technology:**

- Take photos of berries.
- Plan and make a video about berries.
