Writing Activities:

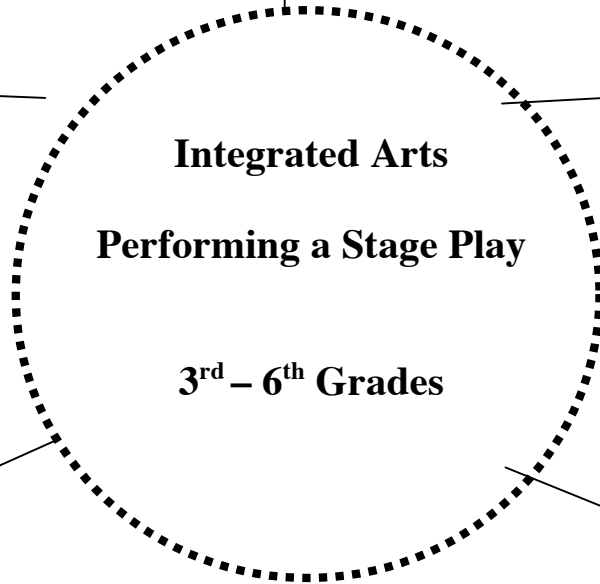
- Edit the script based on appropriateness
- Identify and list props & costumes needed
- Journal about progress
- Adapt scenes
- Identify theme of each scene (student/character)
- Write narration (script) for a *making of...* video

Reading Activities:

- Read the play out loud to become familiar with the “language” – adapt to personal style.
- Memorize lines
- Rehearse with cast

Technology Activities:

- Create a *Making of...* video
- Interview each actor/character about their part in the play.
- Videotape parts of rehearsals
- Log video weekly as rehearsals progress.



Social Sciences Activities:

- Learn local culture of time period: Tools, Weapons, Clothing, Toys, Pirates, Language/Slang

Arts Activities:

- Design sets
- Design backdrop & Scenery
- Make props
- Design costumes
- Invitations to parents, individual and flyers for community

Health/PE Activities:

- Learn relaxation techniques to help with stage fright.
- Learn proper posture for stage presence.
- Practice stage blocking

Speech:

- Learn to project voice using proper techniques.
- Practice diction
- Rehearse with microphones and learn how to speak clearly into a microphone

Mathematics Activities:

- Create illusion of a ship (or other set props needed) using existing stairs, walls or other items on the stage
